



**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING WIRE TRANSFERS  
USING FORMER BANK ROUTING NUMBERS**

Now that all former **BancAbility** banks have converted into Security Bank of Kansas City systems, the Federal Reserve Bank has set dates in which account holders must discontinue processing *wire transfers* using former bank routing numbers.

**The schedule below indicates the date in which the Federal Reserve Bank will no longer accept wire transfers using a former bank routing number.**

<b>June 30, 2017</b>	<b>Industrial State Bank</b>
<b>August 11, 2017</b>	<b>Valley View Bank &amp; Citizen's Bank of Paola</b>
<b>September 22, 2017</b>	<b>Bank of Lee's Summit, First Bank of Missouri &amp; The Mission Bank</b>

While the Federal Reserve Bank will continue to accept wire transfers for the merged banks through each of the dates listed above, the wire transfer routing numbers for the previous banks are no longer published in the official Federal Reserve Wire Directory. Many financial institutions use this directory. As a result, we've received reports that certain institutions are refusing to accept a wire request using the old routing numbers.

**To avoid this issue, we encourage all customers to begin using the official Security Bank of Kansas City routing number when processing a wire transfer: 101000925**

Please be aware that checks and ACH transactions (i.e. direct deposits, direct payments, etc.) are **NOT** affected by this issue. Those transactions can continue to be processed using the old routing numbers.
